

GMADA to hold draw for IT City plots on June 14

MOHALI: The Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) will hold the draw of lots for allotment of 753 residential plots in IT City on June 14.

The scheme, applications for which closed on May 16, received 16,274 applications for 753 plots of various sizes measuring 100 square yards (sq yd), 150 sq yd, 200 sq yd, 300 sq yd, 400 sq yd and 500 sq yd.

"Barring 17 plots of 400 sq yd

for general category, plots of all other sizes will be allotted to 1,632 applicants of senior citizens and 3,538 of women category," said Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, minister of housing and urban development, in a press statement.

The letters of intent (LoI) will be issued to the allottees in the first week of August and the possession would be handed over to them three months after the date of issuance of the LoI. Development works in IT City are being executed by L&T construction company.

"The department will launch more schemes in the coming months including those involving allotment of Purab Premium Apartments, Sector 88, Mohali, and Eco City-II in New Chandigarh," Bajwa said.
