

2,800 APPLY FOR REGULARISATION OF ILLEGAL COLONIES

CHANDIGARH In response to the policy notified for regularization unauthorized colonies, plots and buildings, Punjab Housing and Urban Development department has so far received approximately 2800 applications. The number includes applications received online and in various Sewa Kendras and designated branches of HDFC bank, an official spokesperson said here on Sunday. For the convenience of Promoters/Colonizers, Resident Welfare Associations and individual plot owners, assistance in submission of applications is being provided free of cost in the branches of HDFC Bank. At the same time, applications are being accepted in the Sewa Kendras in different districts at a nominal processing fee of Rs. 1000 from promoters and Rs. 300 from the plot holders. Applications received in these branches of the bank and Sewa Kendras are being sent to the offices of respective Special Development Authorities for processing.
