

Coming, two residential schemes on Navratras

THE DEPARTMENT of Housing and Urban Development would launch two housing schemes for allotment of residential plots in different parts of the State this week.

Disclosing this, here on Monday, Housing and Urban Development Minister, Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, Amritsar Development Authority would launch the scheme for inviting applications for allotment of 140 residential plots at new Urban Estate in Batala on October 10, the first day of Navratras. In the scheme, allotment price has been fixed at Rs 9,990. Besides, another scheme would be launched in Bathinda for allotment of 74 residential plots on October 10. Both the schemes would close on November 9.

The Minister said that in both the schemes, preference in allotment would be given to the senior citizens and women applicants as per the decision of the State Government. The provision of allotment under preferential category has been made in the policy for providing social security to the old age and women.

Additional Chief Secretary, Housing and Urban Development, Vini Mahajan, disclosed that the draw of lots for the allotment of plots to the applicants of the schemes would be held on December 11. While the applicants would be depositing 10 per cent price of the plot as earnest money along with application, the next instalment of 15 per cent would be due within 30 days of issuance of LoI. Remaining 75 per cent amount could be paid by the allottee in lump-sum to avail rebate of 5 per cent or otherwise in 6

equated half-yearly instalments with interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum.

Besides, there would be option to submit applications online, where the applicants will have to visit the website www.adaamritsar.gov.in. In online application system, the applicant will have to make payment through RTGS/NEFT. Possession of the plots would be handed over to the allottees within 90 days from the issuance of allotment letter.

State govt set to launch two housing schemes
