E-AUCTION OF PROPERTIES IN STATE FROM OCTOBER 10

CHANDIGARH PUDA and all the other Special Development Authorities (GMADA, PDA, GLADA, JDA, BDA and ADA) working under the Department of Housing and Urban Development would hold the e-auction for disposal of various properties situated across the state in the next month. The e-auction would match the commencement of Navratras on October 10 and would conclude on October 18. Announcing this, here on Monday, Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, Housing and Urban Development Minister disclosed that properties offered in the auction would include institutional sites like hospitals, nursing homes, schools, mixed use chunk sites, residential plots, industrial plots, SCOs and shops. Cities where these properties are located would include Mohali, Patiala, Ludhiana, Amritsar, Jalandhar, Bathinda, Batala, Gurdaspur, Pathankot, Amargarh, Nabha, Kapurthala, Sultanpur Lodhi, Mansa, Malout, Budhlada, Abohar, Moga and Khanna, he said. Notably, this would be the seventh e-auction to be conducted by the department. To ensure better participation of bidders in the auction, department last year had replaced the traditional process of manual auctions with e-auction, said Bajwa, adding that revenue amounting to more than Rs 1,000 crore has been generated from the previously conducted e-auctions.
