MOHALI : The Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) will soon initiate action against those who have encroached on footpaths, road berms and road gullies in violation of the building rules of the authority.

In this regard, the authority's regulatory wing has started identifying the violations across Mohali.

A spokesperson of GMADA said many residents had encroached on footpaths, road berms and road gullies in the form of back gates or unauthorised constructions on the sector dividing roads.
