# GMADA set to offer 900 residential plots

The Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) is all set to offer around 650 residential plots in IT City and approximately 250 plots in Eco City-II.

Giving details, Vini Mahajan, Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Housing and Urban Development-cum-Vice Chairperson, GMADA, said applications in this regard would soon be invited from the public. "The scheme will be floated soon, but first the draw for allotment of land to landowners/oustees (whose land was acquired for these projects) will be held,"

said Mahajan. GMADA had already conducted draws for allotment of plots/booths/bay shops/SCOs to landowners/oustees whose land was acquired in Sector 76-80, she said.

"We have issued letters of intent to these landowners and allotment letters will be issued soon," said Mahajan.

She said GMADA was in the process of acquiring around 4,500 acres in various villages in the surroundings of the airport. "We are keeping in mind the migration of the youth from different areas of the state and from neighbouring states to settle in the town. There will be a huge demand for residential, commercial and industrial land in the time ahead," said Mahajan.
