BDA and Rs 3.61 crore in ADA has been generated. In Ludhiana, a school site was auctioned for Rs 3.90 crore. Other properties for which bids were received include SCOs and plots situated in Ludhiana and Khanna. In Patiala, the successful bid of Rs 11.61 crore was received

for a chunk site. Booths, residential plots and SCFs located in Patiala, Amargarh and Nabha were also auctioned.

THE E-AUCTION conducted by the Punjab Urban Development

## HOUSING E-AUCTION FETCHES RS 59.69-CRORE

CHANDIGARH The e-auction conducted by PUDA and other Special Development Authorities under the Department of Housing and Urban Development has concluded (except that of Greater Mohali Area Development Authority) in which the department has earned a total revenue of Rs 59.69 crore. Highest revenue to the tune of Rs 33.45 crore was fetched from Patiala (PDA), Rs 9.14 crore from Bathinda (BDA), Rs 8.48 crore from Ludhiana (GLADA), Rs 5.01 crore Jalandhar (JDA) auction, and Rs 3.61 crore was earned from Amritsar (ADA). In Ludhiana, a school site was auctioned for Rs 3.9 crore. Other properties for which bids were received include SCOs and Plots situated in Ludhiana and Khanna. In Patiala, successful bid of Rs 11.61 crore was received for a chunk site. Besides, booths, residential plots, SCFs located in Patiala, Amargarh, Nabha were also auctioned. Bathinda Development Authority successfully auctioned SCOs, SCFs and residential plots situated at various urban estates of Bathinda. Properties auctioned under jurisdiction of Amritsar Development Authority include SCOs, booths, shop sites and residential plots situated in Gurdaspur & Amritsar. JDA got successful bidding for residential plot, SCS and SCF located in Jalandhar and Kapurthala. Housing and Urban Development Minister Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa has expressed satisfaction over the outcome of the auction.
