

PUDA announces schedule for filling 194 posts

THE WRITTEN examination for recruitment to various technical and non technical cadres shall be conducted by Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority (PUDA) in the months of September and October. The schedule of the tests to be conducted has been finalized and is available on the website www.puda.gov.in.

Disclosing this, here on Thursday, Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa, Housing and Urban Development Minister stated that the Authority was in the process of recruiting 194 personnel. The state government in its election manifesto had promised to provide Ghar Ghar Naukari and the present recruitment drive is an effort in the direction of fulfillment of that commitment, said Bajwa.

Online applications were invited from eligible candidates for the posts of Sub Divisional Engineer (Civil), Sub Divisional Engineer (Public Health), Sub Divisional Engineer (Electrical), Sub Divisional Engineer (Horticulture), Junior Engineer

(Civil), Junior Engineer (Public Health), Junior Engineer (Electrical), Junior Engineer (Horticulture), Junior Engineer (Building), Draftsman (Engineering), Draftsman (Architect), Law Officers, Senior Assistant (Accounts) and Clerk-cum-Data Entry Operators. In response to the posts advertised near about 31000 applications were received.

As per the schedule, the last date for submission of online application fee was July 27 but there were some candidates who had registered themselves online, but were not successful in making the online fee payment. Adopting a humanitarian approach, additional time for depositing the fee in shape of a bank draft was given to the registered applicants, said Bajwa.

Now, the written test for selection of the candidates was to be conducted. Merit shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in this examination and there will be no interview. Accordingly, a time line has been prepared for holding the

written examination, the Minister said.

The e-admit cards of those who had applied for the posts of Sub Divisional Engineer (Public Health, Civil, Electrical and Horticulture) and Junior Engineer (Public Health, Civil, Electrical, Horticulture & Building) and Law Officer have been uploaded on the website www.puda.gov.in on September 19. The test for these cadres shall be held on September 23, 2018 and final result shall be uploaded on the website after 5 pm on October 10.

While the uploading of the e-admit cards of the applicants of posts of Draftsman (Engineering & Architecture), Senior Assistant (Accounts) and Clerk Cum-Data Entry Operator would be there on October 10, 2018, the written test for these posts has been scheduled for October 14, 2018. The result of these posts shall be uploaded on the website on November 5, 2018 after 5:00 PM. Written test for all the cadres shall be held at various centres in Chandigarh.

For 194 posts, PUDA receives around 31,000 applications

THE PUNJAB Urban Development Authority (PUDA) has received around 31,000 applications for 194 posts of technical and non-technical staff. The written exam for these posts will be held on September 23 and October 10. The examination centre will be in Chandigarh, said officials.

PUDA invited applications for the posts of Sub Divisional Engineer (Civil), Sub Divisional Engineer (Public Health), Sub Divisional Engineer (Electrical), Sub Divisional Engineer (Horticulture), Junior Engineer (Civil), Junior Engineer (Public Health), Junior Engineer (Electrical), Junior Engineer (Horticulture), Junior Engineer (Building), Draftsman (Engineering), Draftsman (Architect), Law Officers, Senior Assistant (Accounts) and Clerk-cum-Data Entry Operators in July.

Disclosing this, state Housing and Urban Development Minister Tript Rajinder Singh Bajwa said PUDA was in the process of recruiting 194 personnel to fill up the vacancies and also streamline the functioning of the department. He added that due to the vacancies, there were problems in carrying out many important works.

"Now, the written test for selection of the candidates is to be conducted. Merit shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in this examination and there will be no interview. Accordingly, a timeline has been prepared for holding the written examination," Bajwa said.
