Pay water bill through cheque

Mohali: In a relief to residents, the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) has started accepting payment against water bills and sewerage cess up to Rs 10,000 through a cheque. Earlier, the payment was being made either through a demand draft or in cash. Residents of Sectors 65-69, 76-80 and Aerocity, IT City and Eco City-1, New Chandigarh, will be benefited by the move. Consumers will have to pay their bill through cheque three days prior to the last date for making the payment. TNS

GMADA: Now, pay water bill, sewerage cess by cheque

MOHALI: In a move to provide relief to Mohali residents, Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) has started accepting payment pertaining to the water bills and sewerage cess amounting up to ₹10,000 by cheque and cash.

Earlier, payment of water bills pertaining to the amount was made through demand draft and cash.

The sectors and projects where the service has been introduced include Sectors 65 to 69, Sectors 76 to 80 and urban estates Aerocity, IT City and Eco City-1, New Chandigarh.

If the consumer opts for making payment through cheque, the person will have to submit it three days prior to the scheduled last date of depositing the amount in cash.

Also, payments of water bills and sewerage cess of an amount of more than ₹10,000 will be accepted in the form of a demand draft.
