

IT City allottees to get plot numbers

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MOHALI : The Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) will soon allot numbers to the letter of intent (LoI) holders of 256.66 square yard residential plots in IT City, Mohali.

This was stated by Punjab housing and urban development minister SS Sarkaria who chaired a meeting at Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority (PUDA) Bhawan, Mohali, to review the works being executed by special development authorities in the state.

Sarkaria inquired about the possession status of 256.66 square yard residential plots in IT City. The officials apprised him that GMADA had already handed over the possession to the allottees who had applied for plots measuring 300 and 500 sq yd under the scheme launched in 2016. However, the area earmarked for the 256.66 sq yd plots could not be developed due to non-issuance of environmental clearance and LoIs were issued only to the applicants who were

successful in the draw of lots, the officials said.

They also said that amended environmental clearance for the IT City project had been obtained from the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority and subsequently on March 4, 2019, a contract for execution of developmental works in the area had been allotted.

OFFICIALS TOLD TO EXPEDITE WORKS

Sarkaria ordered the engineering staff to ensure that works were completed as per schedule so that the allottees did not suffer. The officials assured him that development on the site would be completed within next six months.

Housing and urban development additional chief secretary Vini Mahajan said the staff supervising the developmental works on the site had been instructed to ensure its timely completion. The estate office was also directed to remain prepared for conducting a draw for the allotment of plot numbers to the LoI holders as soon as the development work on the site is completed, she said.
