brings down 6 structures

Mohali: In another action taken against the unauthorized constructions within a week, the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (Gmada) on Thursday demolished six shops, temporary sheds and boundary walls constructed in Chachu Majra village near Aerocity, Mohali. The constructions violated the provisions of Mohali Master Plan and the Punjab New Capital Periphery Control Act.

Giving details, Gmada regulatory estate officer Rohit Gupta said that the owners of the structures, which were demolished on Thursday, had earlier been issued notices, directing them to remove the constructions on their own, but the owners refused to comply with the orders.

Therefore, the authority decided to take action against these illegal constructions and demolished the establishments with the help of JCB machines.

Gupta said: "We have demolished six illegal, out of which two were shops, three were temporary sheds and one was a boundary wall. Gmada will continue this exercise regularly and demolish illegal structures erected on the government land."

IN ANOTHER action against unauthorised constructions, the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) on Thursday.
