

Online access to property details for PUDA allottees

Told to create user ID, register mobile number in office records

In a bid to provide online access to their properties allotted across the state by the Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority (PUDA) and other special development authorities, the department has extended an opportunity to the owners to create username/user ID and register their mobile number in office records.

The move is largely aimed at facilitating the property owners. After creating their user ID and registering their mobile number, property owners will be able to get the latest information in shape of short message services (SMS) pertaining to various services being provided by the authorities on their mobile numbers.

The facility will also provide time to time update to allottees about the status of their applications submitted to offices of various development authorities and also intimate them about the pending installments and any other dues pertaining to their properties.

Notably, the department has already initiated the process to update the details of allottees/owners in its property ledgers from the

information available in the office records. The allottees can register their mobile numbers after creating a unique username and user ID up to June 30 this year by visiting the websites of development authorities. In case, there would be some change in the details, the same would be updated in the process.

“The allottees, who will fail to register or update their mobile numbers/ details, may not be able to avail some of the services being rendered in the offices of various special development authorities,” said the department’s spokesperson.

He said complete information regarding the process to generate the username/user ID and registration of mobile number has been made available on the websites of PUDA and all other special development authorities.



PUDA to provide information to allottees about their properties through SMS

IN A bid to provide information about properties through Short Messaging Services (SMS), the Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority (PUDA) and the development authorities working under its umbrella, have started updating property owners about their properties' records via SMS. It is for the first time that PUDA is providing such a facility.

The allottees could create a new log in user ID on PUDA's website: pbpudaproperties@gmail.com

till June 30. Complete information regarding the process to generate log in user ID is available on the site as well.

PUDA official said the move is largely aimed to facilitate property owners, who after creating their user id and registering their mobile number, would be able to avail latest information of all services offered by the authorities via an SMS on their registered mobile number. The facility would also provide timely updates to the allottees about status of their submitted applications at offices of various development authorities and also intimate them about pending in-

stallments and any other dues pertaining to their properties.

All the development authorities have already initiated the process to update details of allottees in their property ledgers from information available in office records.

"Allottees can register their mobile numbers after creating a unique user ID till June 30. In case, there are some change in the details regarding their application/properties, the same can be updated in the process on the website. Allottees, who will not register their mobile numbers, may not be able to avail the services," the officer added.

A PUDA spokesperson said the new initiatives will make work hassle-free as under the current system, allottees have to constantly visit offices of concerned authorities to get an update or details regarding their properties.

"An important benefit of this initiative will be that NRIs, who are unable to get timely updates regarding their properties here, will now be updated and this will reduce the risk of grabbing properties and reduce corruption in the department as the owners will have no need to visit the offices anymore," said an officer.
