

# GMADA to hold camps every week to facilitate colony regularisation

**MOHALI:** To facilitate and expedite the regularisation process of unauthorised colonies, plots and buildings, the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) will organise a camp every Wednesday at 11am at PUDA Bhawan, Sector 62, Mohali.

In a meeting with the association of the colonisers, housing and urban development minister Sukhbinder Singh Sarkaria instructed all the special development authorities to organise weekly camps to address problems faced by the colonisers and expedite regularisation process.

The promoters had brought this into the notice of the department that a large number of colonisers were interested in getting their colonies regularised as per provisions of the policy notified by the department, but were facing hardships in getting clarification on certain issues mentioned in the policy.

GMADA chief administrator Kavita Singh said that the civic body will hold the camp where applicants will be extended maximum help. Last date of applying for regularisation of unauthorised colonies been extended to October 31, 2019.
