No. 13/14/10-5Hg2/946.—In partial modification of Notification No. 1/2/2002-6HG-H/1684, dated 3rd May, 2002 regarding constitution and establishment of Patiala Urban Planning and Development Authority (PDA, Patiala) for Patiala City and the adjoining areas under Section 29(2) of The Punjab Regional and Town Planning and Development (Amendment) Act, 2006 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the amendments/additions in the above mentioned notification to coincide the boundaries of Patiala Urban Planning and Development Authority with the boundaries of notified Local Planning Area, Patiala Urban Planning and Development Authority with the boundaries of notified Local Planning Area, Patiala. The Jurisdiction of PDA-Patiala is shown on revised Drawing No. D.T.P.(P) 3502/10, dated 12th March, 2010. The list of villages falling in the boundary is annexed. The revised schedule of boundaries of Patiala Urban Planning and Development Authority (PDA, Patiala) is as under —

## SCHEDULE OF BOUNDARY

North: Starting from point 'A' which is the meeting point of Western boundary of village Rakhra and Northern boundary of Patiala-Nabha Road; thence moving towards East along the Northern boundary of village Rakhra (H.B. 37), village Mund Khera (H.B. 7), village Balipur (H.B. 5), village Sidhoowal (H.B. 36), crossing Patiala-Bhadson Road; thence along the Northern boundary of village Jassowal crossing B.M.L. Canal; thence again along the Northern boundary of village Jassowal (H.B. 22) village Seuna (H.B. 24), village Baran (H.B. 35), up to point 'B' which is the meeting point of common village boundary of village Baran and thardaspur with Northern boundary of village Baran; thence towards North along the Western boundaries of village Hardaspur (H.B. 85), village Kastann (H.B. 335), village Phagan Majra (H.B. 334) and village Amampur (H.B. 333) up to point 'C' which is the meeting point of Western boundary of village Amampur and common boundary of district Patiala and Fatehgarh Sahib; thence towards East along the common boundary of district Patiala and Fatehgarh Sahib; crossing Patiala-Sirhind Road up to point 'D' which is the meeting point of Eastern boundary of village Sehra (H.B. 275) and common boundary of district Patiala and Fatehgarh Sahib.

Starting from point 'D' towards South along the Eastern boundary of village Sehra (H.B. 275). East: village Sehri (H.B. 276), village Akari (H.B. 278) and village Akar (H.B. 277); thence towards East along the Northern boundary of village Shankerpur (H.B. 99); thence towards East along the Northern boundary of village Gauns Pura (H.B. 100); thence toward South along the Eastern boundary of village Gauns Pura (H.B. 100) crossing Patiala-Rajpura Railway line; thence towards South along the Eastern boundary of village Gaunspura then towards Bir Kauli (H.B. 102) crossing Patiala-Rajpura Road (H.B. 64); thence along the North-Eastern boundaries of village Bir Kauli, village Nararu (H.B. 100); thence along the East and Southern boundaries of village Ghumanan (H.B. 105), Eastern boundary of village Shahpur Afghanan (H.B. 104), Eastern, Southern boundary of village Pandtan (H.B. 103); thence towards South along the Eastern and South-Eastern boundary of village Rai Pur (F.B. 110), village Budhanpur (H.B. 116), village Assarpur (H.B. 115), village Kartar Pur (H.B. 119), village Bir Sanaur (H.B. 121), village Todar Pur (H.B. 120), village Lalina (H.B. 126) and village Khooda (H.B. 128); thence towards West along the Southern boundary of village Fatehpur-Rajputan (H.F. 139), village Hiragarh (H.B. 148), crossing Patiala-Bhunemeri road up to point 'E' which is the common point of Western boundary of Patiala-Bhunerheri road and Southern boundary of village Hiragarh (H.B. 148).

Starting from point 'E' towards South-West along the Southern boundary of village Hiragarh South: (H.B. 148) and village Akaut (H.B. 147); thence moving toward West along Southern and Western boundary of village Kule Majra (H.B. 142), crossing Patiala-Cheeka road; thence moving towards South along the Southern boundary of village Sunianheri (H.B. 141), village Ramgarh (H.B. 163); thence moving towards West along the Southern boundary of village Ramgarh (H.B. 163), village Kheri Jattan (H.B. 164), crossing Patiala-Dakala road Thence moving towards West along the Southern boundary of village Khusropur (H.B. 165), village Main (H.B. 34), village Kakrala (H.B. 62), crossing Patiala-Samana Road and Bhakra Main Line Canal; thence again along the Southern boundaries of village Dhalawarpur (H.B. 61), Dhakraba (H.B. 93), thence along the Eastern boundary of village Paharpur (H.B. 23); thence Eastern and Southern boundary of village Bir Sarkar (H.B. 76), then towards West along the Southern boundary of village Bir Sarkar (H.B. 76), village Kheri Malan (H.B. 75); thence along the Eastern and Southern boundary of village Kooka (H.B. 74) and Southern and Western boundary of village Laluchhi (H.B. 67) and village Sadarpur (H.B. 68) up to point 'F' which is the meeting point of Western boundary of village Sadarpur and Southern boundary of Patiaia-Sangrur Road (N.H. 64).

West: Starting from point 'F' toward North crossing Patiala-Sangru road (N.H. 64) along the Northern boundary of village Sardarpur (H.B. 68) and South-Eastern boundary of village Chahchona (H.B. 72) then along the Western boundaries of village Bhedpur (H.B. 52), village Sultanpura (H.B. 51), village Sheikhupur (H.B. 50), village Barsat (H.B. 47), village Kheri Musalmaniya (H.B. 181), village Dhablan (H.B. 178), crossing Patiala-Nabha Railway Line; thence along the Western boundary of village Dhablan (H.B. 178) and village Rakhra (H.B. 37), crossing Patiala-Nabha Road, up to point 'A' which is the starting point.
